 - iii. Kensington can have a one-time event for an estimated \$70,000.
 - iv. Kelly Moore on San Pablo in Albany paint but you need to call to make sure they have space.
 - v. The El Cerrito Recycling Center accepts many different kinds of waste (e.g., ewaste) although it does not have the capacity to accept HHW from Kensington, nor does Bay View have an agreement for El Cerrito to accept HHW from Kensington.
