

Supplies for Neighborhood Shed

Storage unit (such as Rubbermaid) that can be locked with two combination locks (no keys which get lost). It should sit on a cement pad to keep moisture out.

List of households with emergency information

Map of neighborhood properties with location of gas & water turn offs

Large pad of paper to make notes on & Sharpies

ABC fire extinguishers

Generator

Gas in plastic cans with stabilizer (must be changed annually) & funnel

Gas chain saw

Engine oil

Gas siphon for getting gas out of cars

Big halogen lights on stands

50' extension cords

First aid kit- see household list plus add pieces of cardboard for splints & old sheets

Goggles, work gloves, dust masks, hard hats

Hoses and nozzles

Flashlights & lanterns with extra batteries (must be checked every 6 months)

Head lamps

Canopy

Plastic sheeting

Staple gun

Food grade water containers (optional because everyone should have their own)

Tarps, mylar blankets

Two-way radios (optional)

Battery powered AM/FM radio

Portable toilet or bucket with lid

Plastic garbage bags

Chlorine bleach & eye dropper to purify water

Crow bar, wrenches (several sizes), hammers, shovel, screw drivers, axes, pliers, nails, screws

Canvas stretcher

Duct tape

Manual can openers

Tent (optional) for injured & elderly

Water purifier (optional)

Utility shut off wrenches
