#### SERGEANT'S SUMMARY:

Due to the nice weather there is an increase in bicycle and pedestrian traffic in Kensington, at all hours of the day and night. I would urge bicyclist, motorist, and pedestrians to watch out for each other and slow down. Take your time and

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act responsibly, obeying all laws and being aware of your surroundings. I would like to remind bicyclists that you are subject to the same rules of the road as motor vehicles. We have contacted numerous bicyclists at night without the proper lighting and also those proceeding through traffic controlled intersections in violation of the California Vehicle Code. Just because you don't see a vehicle, bicyclist, and or a pedestrian, does not mean they are not there. I would encourage bicyclists and motor vehicle operators to slow down and follow the California Vehicle Code or you are subject to citation.

#### SIGNIFICANT EVENTS:

KPD officers responded but according to the victim the suspects fled when they recognized him. Further investigation revealed the subjects were attempting to burglarize a residence on Franciscan Way by smashing a glass pane on a residence's back door. Several possible suspects were developed by both KPD and ECPD but the El Cerrito resident has failed to positively identify any of them as the suspects who robbed him. This case is under investigation.

#### 12-3834

On 6/9/12 a vehicle which was parked on the street was stolen from the 100 block of St. Albans Rd. It was recovered the next day on Sunset Dr. There are no investigative leads in this case.

#### 12-4248

On 6/24/12 a residential burglary was reported on the 600 block of Canon Dr. The residents were out of town but the house was being watched by a house sitter. This case is under investigation.

#### 2011-1618 Homicide.

On 03-12-11, KPD Officers were dispatched to a possible dead body in the 00 block of Arlington Avenue. The individual was pronounced dead at the scene. This case is being investigated as a homicide.

12-3466 On 5/25/12 a residential burglary was reported on Los Altos. The method of entry was a pried/ forced front door. The loss was primarily jewelry.

#### **KPD Crime Statistics**

As a part of my duties I am tasked with presenting monthly and Year to Date (YTD) crime statistics for Kensington. This includes case closure rates and arrest statistics. As you have no doubt noticed when I took over the Detective position I created a new format for reporting statistics in our monthly report. This was to increase efficiency and accuracy in the numbers I present in my reports. There were some initial errors in my excel formulas which were caught and fixed. As of this report I believe I have eliminated all flaws in the spreadsheet's tabulation formulas.

My goal by the end of the calendar year is to present a completely accurate picture of Kensington's crime statistics so that moving forward it will give us a clearly established base line in which to compare subsequent years of statistics. It will also give us a point of reference to compare our in house statistics with that of the State and Federal Department of Justice. This will allow us to identify and eliminate the reasons for discrepancies between their Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) numbers and our own.

This is an ongoing process of re-evaluation and adjustment as we try to perfect our in house review system, become more proficient on the intricacies of our Aegis record keeping system, and mirror UCR Part 1 criteria. Both the Aegis reporting system and the UCR system are complex. We are working with individuals at other local agencies that are helping to train and educate us, as many have experienced similar struggles as KPD with the Aegis program.

This month, as I previously determined will be periodically necessary, I conducted and audit of my in house crime statistics for the months of January through May. The purpose was to update case status statistics (pending/ suspended/ closed), and re-evaluate the definition of the crime categories I have been using. Once I feel the crime categories no longer need adjustment I plan to audit the case status statistics quarterly.

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What this all means is in the coming months, you will notice a few new crime categories, and a few removed, or combined with another category. Also each time I do a status audit you will also notice many open/ pending cases will be closed or suspended as we make arrests or exhaust investigative leads.

I will take care to note when these audits or changes take place so everyone stays informed. I hope this explanation clears up any past confusion regarding my crime statistics and identifies what can be expected for the future.

As reported above in Detective Stegman's report, we are continuing to refine and fine tune the way in which we report our crime statistics in order to provide the community and other law enforcement agencies we report to the most accurate and up to date crime information.

However, I have already broken my first rule that I made to myself in preparing this report. Upon review of Detective Stegman's submitted report, I noticed that he had reported in his Year To Date report that we had one reported homicide. The only homicide we have had in the past 28 years now is the one that occurred in March of 2010. That case is still unsolved and is carried in Detective Stegman's report has an Open/ Pending case. It is not a reported homicide this year to date.

My rule to myself was NOT to make the corrections in Detective Stegman's reports. I was to advise him of the errors I found and have him make the necessary corrections. Well, I noticed the homicide error and I did not have the time to allow Detective Stegman make the correction, so I broke my own rule.

Additionally, I also notice in his Year to Date that he has indicated that we have had three robberies so far this year. I believe the correct total is two, the robbery of a cell phone in February of this year and a purse snatch in April.

Why do I mention this in my portion of the Monthly Report? Because I am trying to convey that the crime statistic reporting is a work in progress. We will strive to continue to audit, revise, formulate, and present the most accurate and up to date crime statistics.

State law (Section 7910 of the Government Code) requires each local government agency to determine during each fiscal year the appropriations limit pursuant to Article XIIIB of the California Constitution applicable during the following fiscal year. The limit must be adopted at a regularly scheduled meeting or a noticed special meeting and the documentation used in determining the limit must be made available for public review fifteen days prior to such meeting.

Set out below is the methodology used to calculate the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 appropriations limit for the District. The limit as set forth below will be adopted at the meeting of the Board of Directors on July 12, 2012.

WHEREAS, Article XIIIB of the California Constitution and Sections 7902(b) and 7910 of the Government Code require that each local agency subject thereto establish by resolution the applicable appropriations limit for each Fiscal Year by applying to the limit for the previous Fiscal Year the factors, as issued by the California Department of Finance, reflecting changes in the California per capita personal income and in population; and

WHEREAS, the calculations showing the applications of those factors have been forwarded to the Board of Directors for review and have been made available for public inspection at least fifteen days prior to the date hereof; and

WHEREAS, the applicable factors for Fiscal Year 2012-2013 are as follows: (1) the increase in the California per capita personal income was 3.77%; and (2) the applicable change in population from January 2011 to January 2012 was 1.01%.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Kensington Police Protection and Community Services District that the appropriations limit for Fiscal Year 2012-2013 be established as \$3,464,995.
